Admissions **FAQ**

Seoul Digital University was established in 2001 as a 4-year online university with 24 majors. Graduates receive a bachelor's degree and qualify to go on to graduate schools or get employed in and outside the country. SDU has the most graduates of all online universities in Korea.

Q Is Seoul Digital University a university accredited by the Ministry of Education?

Seoul Digital University is a four-year full-time online university under the Higher Education Act established in 2001. Graduates of 24 departments (majors) are awarded a bachelor's degree in the name of the university president and can enter well-known graduate schools in Korea and abroad, get a job, and obtain a national certificates.

What is the difference between SDU and regular

All of our classes and exams are done online, so you don't have to be physically present in the classroom. As a result, a lot of public officials and workers take classes at SDU because they can maintain a job and study at the same time. Furthermore, tuition at SDU is about one-fourth the cost of other universities.

Q. Who goes to SDU?

We have a wide variety of students ranging from recent high school graduates to people who are over 50s; the majority of students are in their 20s to 40s. People who live outside Korea take classes through us as well. Recently, the number of technical college graduates and workers with high school diplomas has been increasing.

Q. How do I take classes and exams?

We have two semesters each year, and classes and exams are all done online. You can also use a smartphone to take classes and review lectures for up to four years after you have completed them. We don't have mid-term exams, just finals. Tests consist of multiple-choice and essay questions.

Q. How is the grading evaluation done?

The grades are given by various evaluation items such as lecture attendance, academic attitude, assignments, quizzes, and final exams for each subject. The evaluation rate varies depending on the course, but over 70% of the students are receiving scores of 2.0 or higher.
